Sermon: Cultivating a Culture of Generosity

2 Corinthians 9:6-15

(optional reading: 2 Corinthians 8:16-24 & 2 Corinthians 9)

Questions:

1. 2 Corinthians 9:6-15 was addressed to the Corinthian Church as a whole and, with the exception of verse 7, the pronouns 'you' are plural. Does this affect how we understand and apply this passage? If so, how?
2. Verse 8 says "God will generously provide all you need." Does the understanding of this change when we understand the 'you' as plural (i.e., the church)?
3. What does farming and planting seeds have to do with generosity?
4. Paul says we must each decide in our own hearts how much to give. Why is this important?
5. What does it mean that he will create a harvest of generosity 'in you'?
