How can you make an impact on kids around the world?

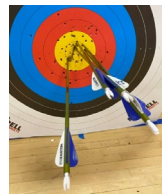

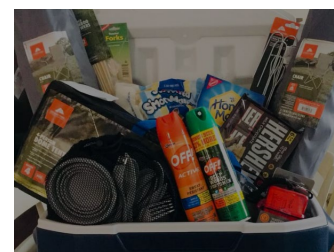

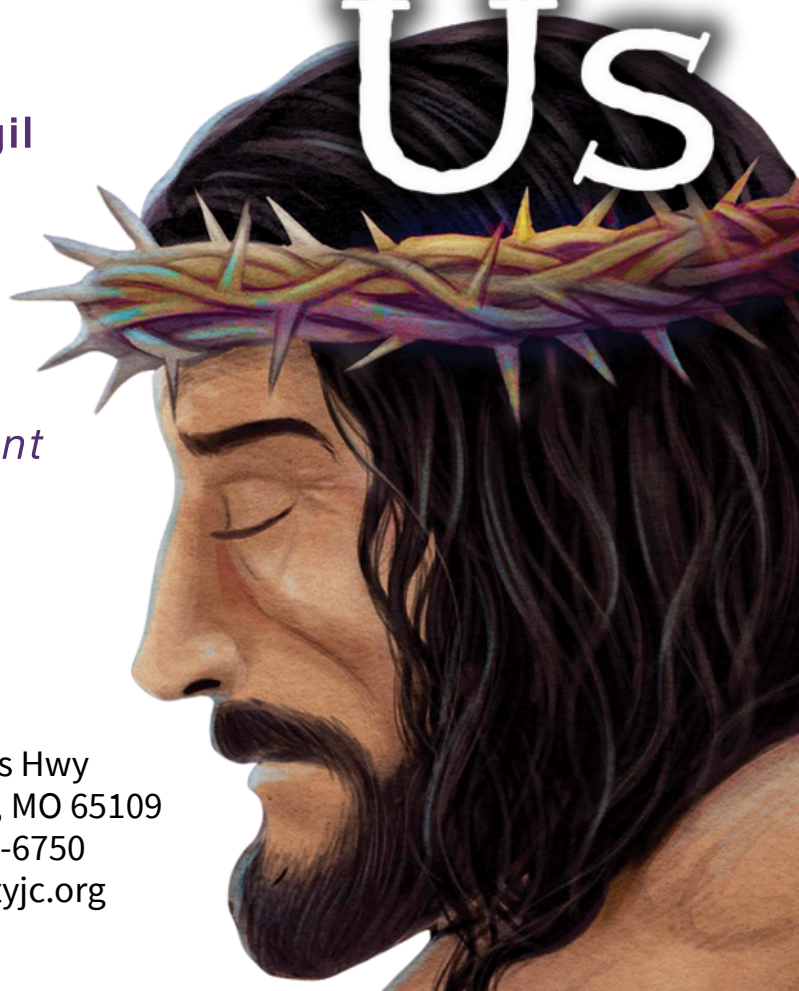

III. Opening Devotion

The fruit of the spirit for February is faithfulness. Faith is the assurance of things hoped for & not seen. Hebrews 11. Remember what it was like to learn to swim. You had to trust something invisible that you would float and believe what the instructor told you. Trusting in Jesus can be like this, he calls us to do things that may seem impossible. He may ask us to say apologize to a friend or maybe something bigger like take care of a foster child. He has never failed us after many years of trusting Jesus.

IV. Bank Report

- some Tigerfest deposits have come in. Some teacher checks have not been cashed.

V. Tiger Tools

- Do we want to allow or allocate part of tiger tools to compensate a person who helps teachers. Mrs. Gibson or Mrs. Hardin.
- Motion to allow some portion of tiger tools budget to contribute to the person's salary. 50% for person & 50% for physical items.
- Discussed just doing whatever funds are left over at the end of the year, then would go towards supplementing the aids.
- Voiced concern of losing the funds. Reassured the teachers will NOT lose funds. Only if funds are left over go towards the aids for the next budget year.
- Aids are paid hourly, so their salary fluctuates, but they work between 20-25 hours a week. They work with Mrs. Brunner.
- Suggestion that tiger tools could also apply towards curriculum.
- Discussion on how to re-allocate the \$\$.
- Consolidate Student Services with Tiger Tools. 15k. 7k for aids & the rest is for tools.
- Concern voiced about making sure to not be micromanaging how the teachers are spending the fund. This is not the intention.
- Motion to increase Tiger Tools budget to 15k, 50% spent on an aid 50% on physical items throughout the year. At end of the year re-evaluate. Motion seconded and all in favor. No against.

VI. Tiger Fest:

Raising \$\$ for security of school. May need more than 1 tiger fest.

Mr. Sprengel asks for no classroom door locks. All replaced within last few years. Replaced where teachers can lock from inside. Biggest security issue is front office. The preference is to reconfigure to make it in the lobby. The other security issue is the full glass wall in the cafeteria.

Pottery for tigerfest is being made tomorrow (2/5/26). Some classes will be out for portions of the day tomorrow. 7th grade will go first, then 2nd & 3rd and then the other grades.

NCAA Swimmer & Advocate for Women

Riley Gaines is a recent graduate from the University of Kentucky where she was a 12-time NCAA All-American swimmer. During the 2022 championships, Riley was forced to compete and share a locker room with transgender swimmer Lia Thomas. Even though she tied with the biological male, the NCAA officials insisted on giving him the trophy. Riley has since become a powerful advocate for conservative causes, fighting to defend the rights of women and preborn babies.
