## S.O.A.P. Devotional

### S – Scripture

Read **John 2:1–11** slowly and prayerfully.

Key verse to focus on:

*“His mother said to the servants, ‘Do whatever he tells you.’”*

—John 2:5

As you read, notice:

- The need that arises at the wedding
- Jesus’ response
- The servants’ obedience
- The result of trusting Christ

### O – Observation

- The setting is a joyful celebration, yet a quiet crisis emerges when the wine runs out.
- Mary brings the need to Jesus without telling Him how to fix it.
- Jesus’ timing seems uncertain, but Mary trusts Him anyway.
- The servants obey a command that doesn’t make sense—filling jars with water instead of finding wine.
- The miracle happens only *after* obedience.
- Jesus transforms ordinary water into the best wine, revealing His glory.
- The result is deeper faith among His disciples.

**Key truth:**

Obedient trust opens the door for God’s transforming work.

### A – Application

Ask yourself these questions:

- Where in my life have I “run out” — joy, patience, hope, strength?
- Have I brought that need honestly to Jesus?
- Is there something Jesus has already told me to do that I’ve been delaying?
- Am I willing to obey even when I don’t understand the outcome?

**Personal Challenge:**

This week, choose one area where you will trust Jesus enough to obey Him fully—without waiting for perfect clarity.

**Write it down:**

Jesus, today You are telling me to \_\_\_\_\_.

### P – Prayer

Pray this prayer, or use your own words:

Lord Jesus,

I bring You the empty places in my life today.

Where I have run out, I ask You to meet me with Your grace.

Help me to trust You even when I don’t understand Your timing or Your ways. Give me a willing heart to do whatever You tell me.

Take what I place in Your hands and transform it for Your glory.

Strengthen my faith as I learn to walk in obedience.
