Living Like It's Here Week 2

Many churches pray for revival, but few actually live like it's already [here](#).

The early church didn't wait for God to move someday they lived every day believing God was already [working](#).

THE PICTURE OF REAL REVIVAL

Acts 2:42–47 (NLT) “All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord’s Supper), and to prayer. A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord’s Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.”

This wasn't a special event.

This was ordinary people living out revival [daily](#).

TRUTH #1 — REVIVAL LOOKS LIKE DEVOTION

“They devoted themselves...”

Revival lasts when people stay [faithful](#), not just fired up.

Revival survives on habits, not [hype](#).

TRUTH #2 — REAL REVIVAL CREATES COMMUNITY

Acts 2 describes a [family](#), not a crowd.

Faith doesn't grow best in rows—it grows best around [tables](#).

TRUTH #3 – GENEROSITY IS A SIGN OF REVIVAL

“They shared everything they had...”

Revival changes what we **value**.

Revival loosens our grip on stuff and tightens our grip on **people**.

TRUTH #4 – CHANGED LIVES DRAW PEOPLE IN

“They enjoyed the goodwill of all the people...”

People weren’t drawn in by an event—they were drawn by a different way of **living**.

BIG TAKEAWAY

1. The early church didn’t wait for revival. They lived like it was already **here**.
2. Revival isn’t an event you attend—it’s a lifestyle you choose.

- What does it look like in your daily life to “live like revival is already here” instead of waiting for a big event?
- Which of the four habits of the early church—devotion, generosity, authentic community, or sharing life—do you find easiest to practice? Which is most challenging?
- How could your life or your home become a “campfire” that draws people in rather than a “fire-work” that burns out quickly?

Put It Into Action This Week

- Invite Someone In: Share a meal, have coffee, or host a small gathering to open your life to another believer or unchurched friend.
- Pray Together: Take intentional time to pray with someone this week—either in person, over the phone, or via video call.
- Meet a Real Need: Identify one tangible need in someone’s life (physical, emotional, or spiritual) and meet it this week as an act of generosity and love.
