



**Life Group Study Questions**  
**Ecclesiastes 5:8-6:12**

1. Read Ecclesiastes 5:8-6:12 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. In our passage the Preacher is saying that discontentment and a longing for more wealth will destroy your life. Have you seen this attitude in your own life? Why is the desire for more wealth and possessions so prevalent in our culture?
3. Read 1 Timothy 6:6-10, 17-19. What similarities do you see in this passage with our passage in Ecclesiastes? Why is the desire for wealth a 'snare'?
4. In Ecclesiastes 6:10-12, the Preacher wants us to remember our place in the universe. Why does remembering who God is and who we are help in the battle against greed and covetousness?
5. What does learning to be content look like? Read Philippians 4:11-13 together. How did Paul learn contentment?
6. What does "finding contentment in Christ" look like? What are practical ways you can daily reorient your heart and mind around him?
