FUUN is supported almost entirely by its members and friends. About **85% of our annual budget comes from pledges**, making them the foundation of everything we do together.

Why We Have a Pledge Campaign

FUUN's fiscal year runs from **July 1 through June 30**.

We hold our pledge campaign in the spring so our Finance Team can create a responsible budget for the year that begins in July.
