

To date DFG's has reached over 3.5 million women and girls.

Our local DFG's team has been hosting work bees here at Ebenezer three times a year for the past 10 years. We have made over 1000 kits which have been part of distributions to Kenya, Rwanda, Ethiopia, Guatemala and World Vision. World Vision sends kits to refugee camps.
