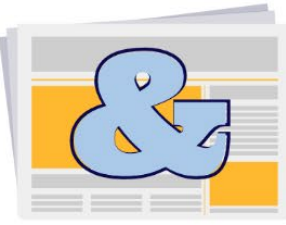

Our present financial situation has led the Church Council to the difficult decision to **temporarily** suspend the call committee for an Associate Pastor. We have significant work to do related to strengthening our financial support for the Church and its programs. Over the coming months we will be discussing how to improve our giving and be responsible stewards with the gifts God has given us.

At the Voters Meeting this week a resolution was passed to support this decision. "With a heavy heart the voter's assembly supports the Church Council's decision to suspend the work of the call committee temporarily." As one member succinctly stated during the meeting, "You can't hire a Pastor on a credit card".

Please keep the Church in your prayers as we navigate these difficult times. The Board of Elders will be working with Pastor to address the time constraints he faces.

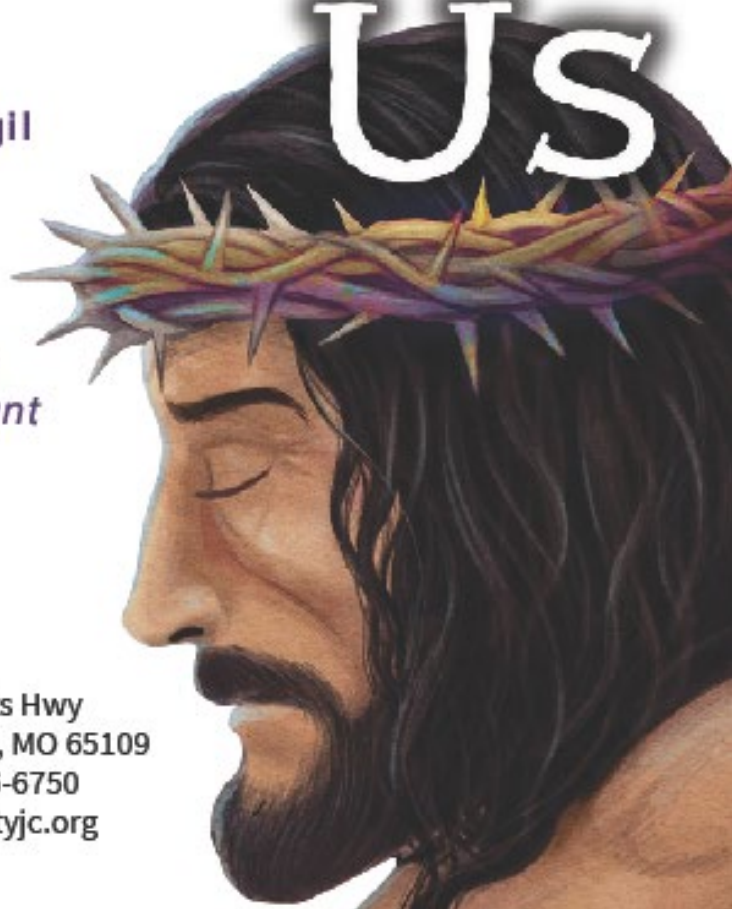

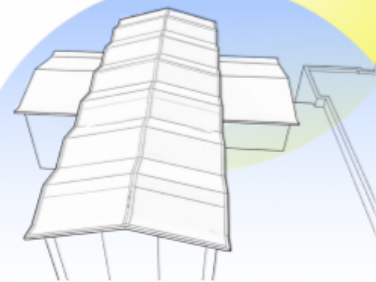

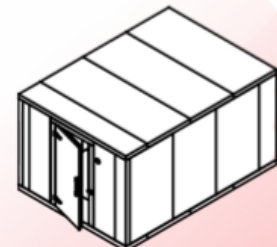

**WORDS OF
WORSHIP**

Dear Words of Worship partners,

As promised, this message begins our weekly series of emails. It is our prayer that this communication is a blessing to you and to all with whom you share the emails within your congregation.

Picture this: A child hears “Thank the Lord and sing His praise” and begins to join in song, “tell ev’ryone what He has done.” A father begins praying “Our Father who art in heaven,” and the family around him folds their hands and continues together. A grandmother picks up a book that her grandchild eagerly placed into her lap, and she gathers both child and book together, pointing out images that relate to faith.

Did you picture these scenarios in the church pew? At home? Somewhere different? It is the prayer of those partnering in *Words of Worship* that the answer will be “all of the above” as it becomes an increasing reality for children, families, and congregations.

This may be the first or the hundredth time you’ve heard the phrase “Words of Worship” as a title for a program. Whether you know much or nothing at all, we hope you’ll finish reading this email with interest and excitement for what we pray God will do through this endeavor.

But first, what is *Words of Worship*? This program equips congregations and families with tools to nurture children’s faith through meaningful, age-appropriate engagement in worship and prayer.

Key objectives include the following:

- Equip parents, caregivers, pastors, and church workers to pass along the faith to children from birth to age 8.
- Develop companion resources to help families use the common language of faith at home.
- Help children to express their faith by nurturing worship and prayer practices.

This program is made possible by a \$1.25 million grant from Lilly Endowment Inc. through its Nurturing Children Through Worship and Prayer Initiative.

So, what does this mean for you? If you’re reading this email, your congregation is part of a cohort that has partnered in this program in a meaningful way. CPH will provide several cohorts with free training and resources designed to engage children in worship. Congregations will provide feedback throughout the process to help cultivate a program that congregations across the LCMS can use.

Please pray with your congregation, fellow congregations, and all involved in the *Words of Worship* program so that these partnerships bear fruit in the ways children use words of worship throughout the week and throughout their lives.
