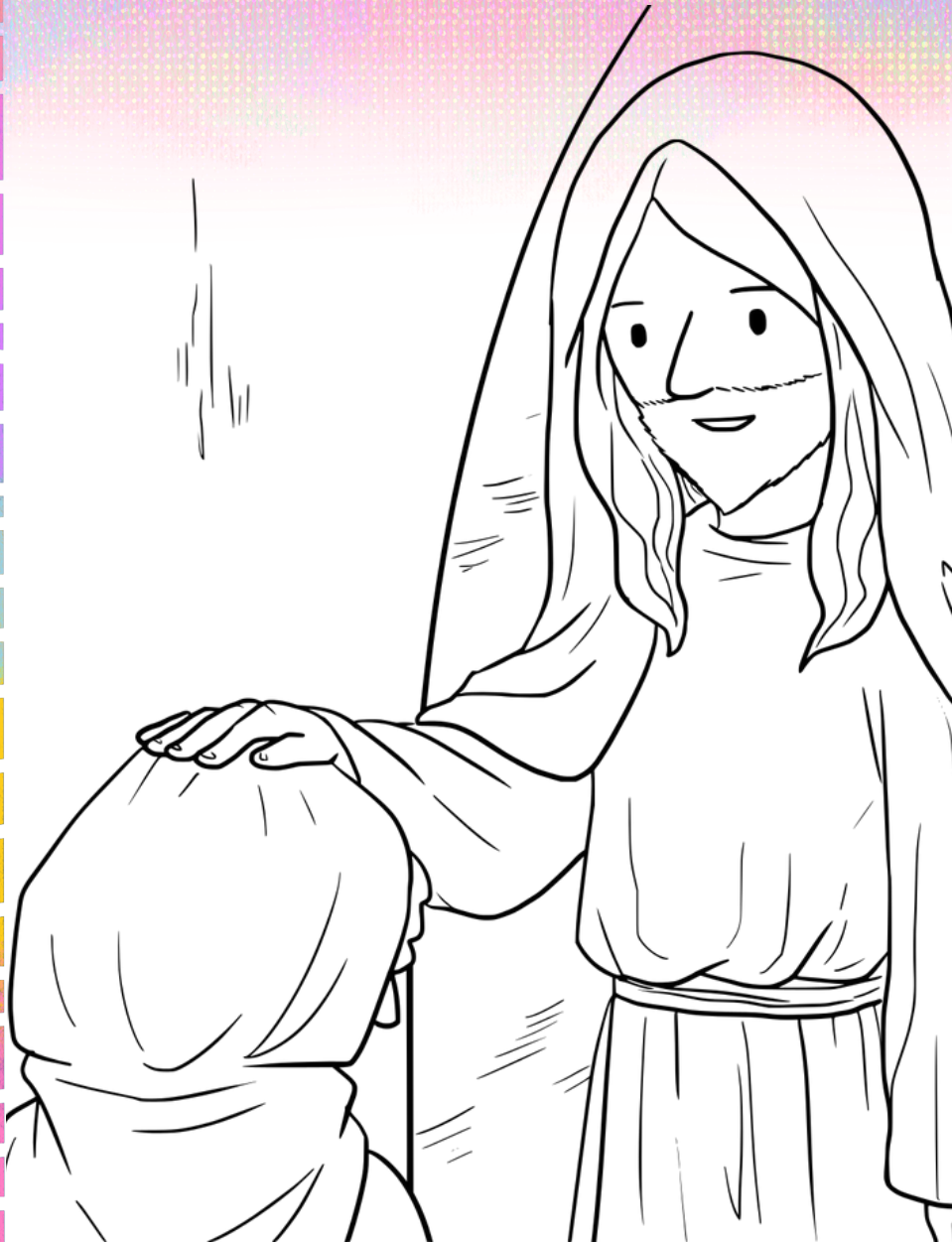

The Man Born Blind

Jesus' friend, Philip, pointed to a blind man. He asked, "Is that man blind because his parents did something bad? Or because he did something bad?"

Jesus shook his head. "Everyone believes bad things only happen to people because they did something wrong. But it's not true. It's no one's fault that this man is blind. But it's up to us to show God's love by caring for and healing them."

With that, Jesus cured the man of his blindness. The man believed that Jesus was God's promised messiah, and followed Jesus after that.

Some people didn't want to believe that Jesus was God's promised one. Jesus said to his friends, "Some people do not want to see the truth about me. They are the ones who are truly blind."
