Qualifications

Volunteers should:

- Be able to **lift, move, and carry materials** as needed

Responsibilities

As a **Property and Grounds Volunteer**, you will:

- **Occasionally Perform minor repairs** (fixing furniture, replacing light bulbs, basic carpentry, etc.)
- **Assist with Annual landscaping** (weeding, adding mulch to flower beds, planting flowers, edging and weeding, etc.)

- **Support occasional custodial work** (deep cleaning, organizing storage, etc.)

Expectations

- **Commitment:** Serve on an as-needed basis or participate in scheduled workdays
- **Teamwork:** Work alongside other volunteers in a spirit of **unity and service**
- **Safety First:** Follow safety procedures when using tools and handling repairs
