Qualifications

1. Physical Capability

3. Attention to Detail

- Understands room layouts and follows instructions accurately when arranging tables and chairs.

Responsibilities

1. Set-Up

- Arrive before scheduled services or events to set up chairs in the auditorium according to the room layout or arrange tables in designated areas for events (e.g., fellowship gatherings, classes, special meetings).

- Ensure all rows, aisles, and walkways meet required spacing for both comfort and safety.

2. Tear-Down

- Stay after services or event to ensure the room is set up correctly for next scheduled ministry use.

3. Organization & Storage

- Ensure tables and chairs are stored safely in designated areas. Report any damage or malfunction to ministry leads.
- Return items to their appropriate storage areas in a clean, orderly manner. Maintain a tidy storage room and help manage inventory when asked.

1. Serve with a Positive Attitude - Display joy and enthusiasm as you serve.

2. Consistency and Commitment

- Give advance notice if you are unable to serve on your assigned day.

3. Follow Safety Guidelines

- Use proper lifting techniques and request assistance with heavy items.
- Keep pathways clear and abide by any additional church safety procedures.

4. Focus on Excellence

- Strive to create an environment that is neat, organized, and welcoming to everyone who enters our church. Pay attention to room layouts, and overall presentation to ensure a professional appearance.
