Role Title: Connections Ministry Volunteer

Purpose: To create a welcoming environment for guests attending **First Step** and **Next Steps** classes, ensuring they feel valued, informed, and encouraged to take their next step in faith at FCC.

Qualifications:

- A growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- A heart for hospitality and anticipating the needs of others
- Good communication and people skills
- Dependability and ability to arrive on time for scheduled service
- Ability to serve with a team and follow event guidelines
- A commitment to the vision of FCC: *Real People, Real Life*

Responsibilities:

Before the Event:

- Greet and welcome attendees as they arrive.
- Assist with check-in and provide any needed materials (handouts, pens, etc.).
- Engage in light conversation to make guests feel at ease.

During the Event:

- Help maintain a warm and welcoming atmosphere.
- Assist in guiding attendees to seating areas and provide support if they have questions.
- Serve as a table host if needed—engaging in discussion and encouraging participation.
- Monitor hospitality areas and restock as necessary.

After the Event:

- Assist with clean-up, including putting away food and decorations and other materials.
- Ensure all trash is disposed of and the room is left in good condition.
- Follow up with Connection Coordinator about any guest needs or concerns that arose.

Expectations:

- Serve with joy, kindness, and a welcoming attitude.
- Be **on time** and **fully present** when scheduled.
- Communicate in advance if you are unable to serve on your scheduled day.
- Be prayerful and intentional about helping people connect to the church and grow in their faith.
