Separate Us from

39 ... *(nothing)* shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.



***No Condemnation,
No Separation!***

1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus.

39 ... *(nothing)* shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
