The last couple of weeks have been extremely strange for us. I don't think I have missed church 2 weeks in a row since I started in ministry. Two weeks ago we were dealing with a significant amount of snow and last weekend we were blessed to go on the youth trip. I love snow so both were good weekends, but still I missed being in church. There is something very special about the people of God coming together, lifting up the name of Jesus, spending time in God's word, and fellowshiping together.

That is why the writer of Hebrews tells us "to not give up meeting together". The word for give up or neglect actually means to forsake a fixed location. Our fixed location, one of the hubs of our life should be the church. It is a place that we order our lives around and that we should make a priority. God has given us the church for our own good. He wants us to have a place to join with other Christians so that we can fellowship, pray, study, be encouraged, and worship together. The house of God really is that important.

We should make church a priority and we should love to come to church but we are also told that we are to "be the church". 1 Peter 2:5 puts it this way, "you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." We are being built into the house of God. We are to be the church. Paul tells us the same thing in 1 Corinthians 6:19 when he says that our bodies are the temples of the Holy Spirit. We are to be the church!

How can we do that? We can get involved in the ministries of the church (if you're curious about opportunities come to the next planning meeting which is Saturday at 10 AM). We can pray for the ministries of the church. Spend time asking God to do a great work through the ministry of things like SPOT and the other ministries of the church. Get involved in Wednesday night Bible study or in a Sunday school class. Find a way to encourage someone that is hurting or struggling. Invite a co-worker to church. Share your testimony with them. Take time to pray for people or take time to pray WITH people. You could volunteer at a local school, or at Isaiah 117 House. We help with a homeless/addiction ministry called Freeway in Kingsport the first Sunday of every month and they are always looking for people to help serve. There is all sorts of ways to get involved and be the church. So come to church and be the church. It is a privilege and a calling for each of us.
