



**MARK: THE SERVANT KING  
CROWDS AND CONSECRATION**

Mark 3:7-21

**BIG IDEA:** Jesus calls followers, not just crowds.

**THE CROWDS COME FOR WHAT JESUS CAN DO (vv. 7-12)**

Many are drawn to Jesus for relief, not relationship.

Jesus' power draws attention; His mission demands transformation.

**JESUS CALLS THE TWELVE TO CONSECRATION (vv. 13-15)**

Consecration starts with being set apart for Jesus' mission.

Ministry is based on intimacy with Jesus.

**JESUS SENDS SET APART PEOPLE ON MISSION (vv. 16-19)**

Jesus uses ordinary people to accomplish His purposes.

Those separated unto Jesus are those sent by Jesus.

**CONSECRATION OFTEN LEADS TO MISUNDERSTANDING (vv. 20-21)**

Devotion to Jesus will be misinterpreted-even by our family and friends.

Faithfulness to God matters more than the approval of people.
