At Calvary . . . with Pastor Davis

I have had these verses from **Proverbs 27** in my mind:

²³ *Be diligent to know the state of your flocks,
And attend to your herds;
²⁴ For riches are not forever,
Nor does a crown endure to all generations.*

I have had these verses in mind as it relates to our Facilities Committee. To *Be diligent to know the state of your flocks, and attend to your herds* is a sound admonition to take care of things. It has application in keeping track of what is going on in your family and to note areas that need time and attention. Such things need to be managed by diligence. *Attend*[ing] to them is to not just *know* what needs to do or to simply “have it on the

list” but to give attention to it — to take the time, to *make* the time to address that which needs addressing. The same is true with things outside of the relational realm. We need to pay attention to creaks and clangs in our homes and our vehicles and address areas that need work. We never catch everything and maintenance does not cure all ills, but consistent care acknowledges that diligence needs to be applied to managing rather than assuming *a crown endure*[s] *to all generations*. (These things won’t be around later on if they are not tended to now.)

The Facilities Committee tends well to such matters around our building very consistently. Recently, the weekly check of the boilers (be honest, when is the last time you wondered about and had the diligence *to know the state of* the boilers around here?) revealed the need for some special maintenance and that is being dutifully addressed. It made me so grateful that God has given us faithful people who have a diligent mind to care for that which the Lord has entrusted to us so that, Lord willing, we will have a building that will *endure* and continue to be functionally used for many years ahead.

So, this post is in gratitude for those who do such work. Appropriately so, we have in mind the ministry of those who work with the children in the nursery, Sunday School, Children’s Church, and Awana. We value the faithful work of Evidence and our adult ministries and pretty much all of those elements use the building. Thank you, Facilities Committee, for your diligence in attending to such aspects of the ministry of CMC that otherwise would go unnoticed and fall into neglect.

One of the ways you can be a help is to mark your calendars for Saturday, February 28, from 9 am-noon to come do some of the maintenance matters that need attention. It is not the responsibility of the Facilities Committee to *do* all the work, they have been tasked with keeping an eye on such things to let the *church* know what needs to be done, so we can all lend a hand to complete the work.
