Unshakeable: A Faith That Won't Fold - Part 2

"Facing Impossible Situations"

Daniel 2:1-23

At one time or another in our lives, all of us will face difficult situations, circumstances, and challenges. In fact, many of you may be facing what seems to be an impossible situation going on in your life right now. And some of you are feeling like it is overwhelming you and you are just surviving instead of thriving.

And so, if you are finding yourself stuck between a rock and a hard place; if you are in a very difficult place in life; if you are facing a difficult challenge or situation in life; you will identify with the people in Daniel chapter 2. In this chapter, we meet people who are facing a very difficult situation, and we see their responses to the challenges in their life.

Daniel and his friends show how to keep your head when everyone else is losing theirs. They help us see how we can face some seemingly impossible situations in life and not just survive but spiritually thrive. They help us see how we can be *Unshakeable*, and live with *A Faith That Won't Fold*.
