Take Up The Shield of Faith

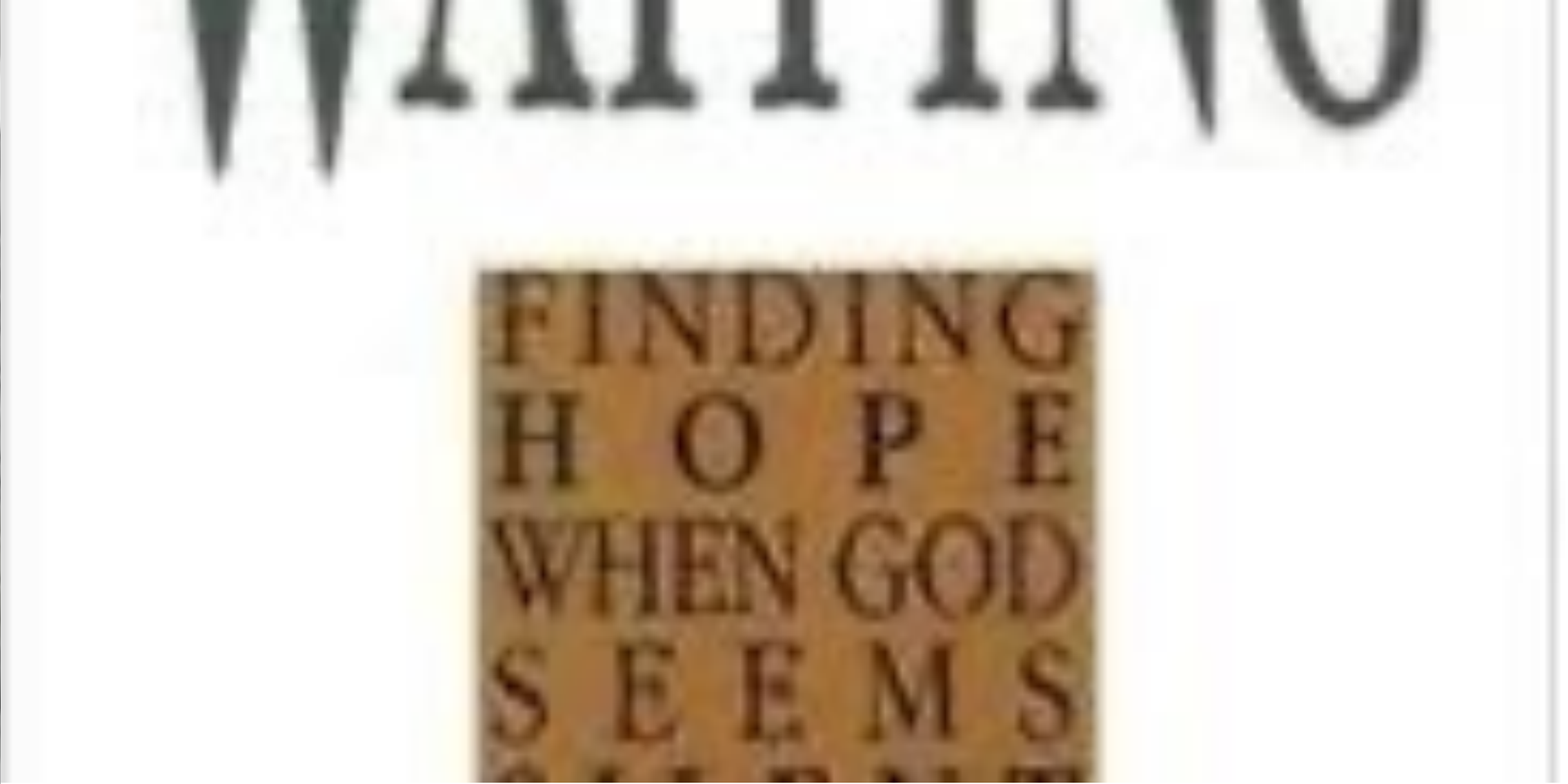
