## ***Member Testimony - Natalie Watson***

My name is Natalie Watson. I've been going to Buckeye Baptist for almost 8 years. I wanted to share a little about the work I've seen God doing in my life. As some of you may know, I was diagnosed with Friedreich's Ataxia on June 24, 2011. I have seen some of the ways Christ has used my diagnosis for His glory. This diagnosis has resulted in numerous trials that have tested both my mental and physical strength, but it has also given me the opportunity to connect with so many people who I otherwise wouldn't have been able to connect with. For example, nurses and other medical staff in the hospital, as well as other people within the FA community. My diagnosis also ultimately led me to Christ due to the intense feelings of fear and isolation I experienced. Jesus Christ gave me something to fight for and something I didn't think I'd ever be able to have- hope for the future.

Then, 3 years ago, on June 24, 2022, I was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis. Having both FA and MS is basically unheard of. So, at first, I thought I did something very wrong to have earned myself 2 chronic diseases. However, as soon as I realized that my MS diagnosis was on the same day as my FA diagnosis, I knew exactly who was in control. I knew that God was telling me I would be alright, and this is a part of His plan for me. He would use my Multiple Sclerosis diagnosis for His glory, just as He has used my Friedreich's Ataxia diagnosis for His glory. He has given me a unique set of experiences and trials for a reason, and I just have to be open and willing to allow Him to use me.
