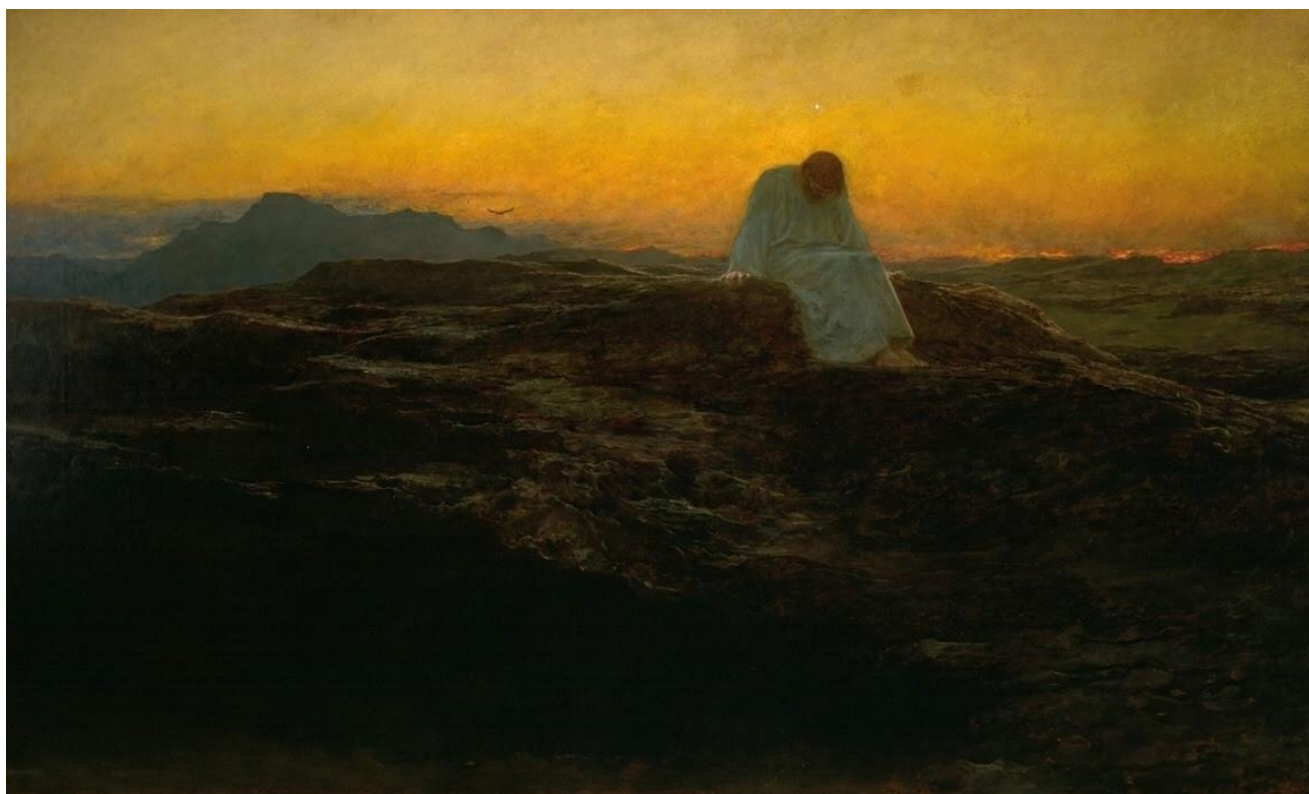

Ash Wednesday
