

REFLECTION Questions

JOHN 2:1-12

- Is the symbolism of the wine speaking to the spiritual barrenness of the Israelites?
 - See Psalm 104:15 and Proverbs 3:10
- Was Mary suggesting something to Jesus with her statement? If so, what?
- Why did Jesus respond the way that he did? Did Mary understand his response? If so, what did her instructions to the servants mean?
- What does “my hour” in Jesus’ response refer to?
- Was there any significance to the amount of wine?
 - See Jeremiah 31:12, Joel 3:18, and Amos 9:13-14.
- What is the significance of the quality comparison that was made?
- John says that this was Jesus’ first “sign.” What is a “sign” in this context, and why are Jesus’ signs important?
- Why was what happened not told to anyone else? Why did the servants not tell others of what happened?
- To whom was the glory of Jesus revealed?
- Was this the beginning of his called disciples’ faith?
- Was this the beginning of the fulfillment of John 1:51?
