The Need for Shepherds: The Biblical Story

*What sorrow awaits you shepherds who feed yourselves instead of your flocks. Shouldn't shepherds feed their sheep?....You have **not strengthened the weak or healed the sick or bound up the injured. You have not brought back the strays or searched for the lost. Instead, you have ruled them with harshness and cruelty.** ⁵ So my sheep have been scattered without a shepherd, and they are **easy prey** for any wild animal. ⁶ They have wandered through all the mountains and all the hills, across the face of the earth, yet **no one has gone to search for them.***

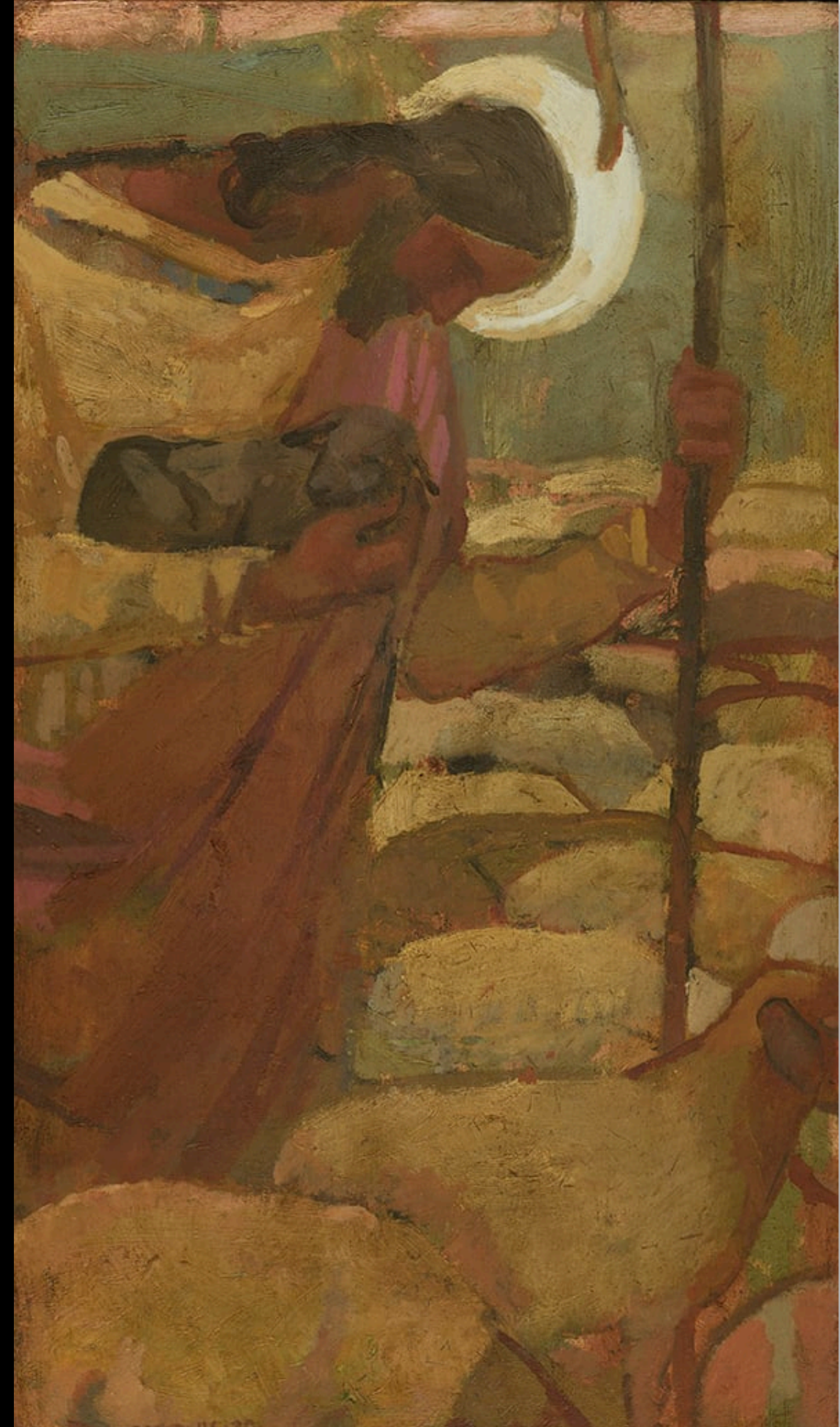

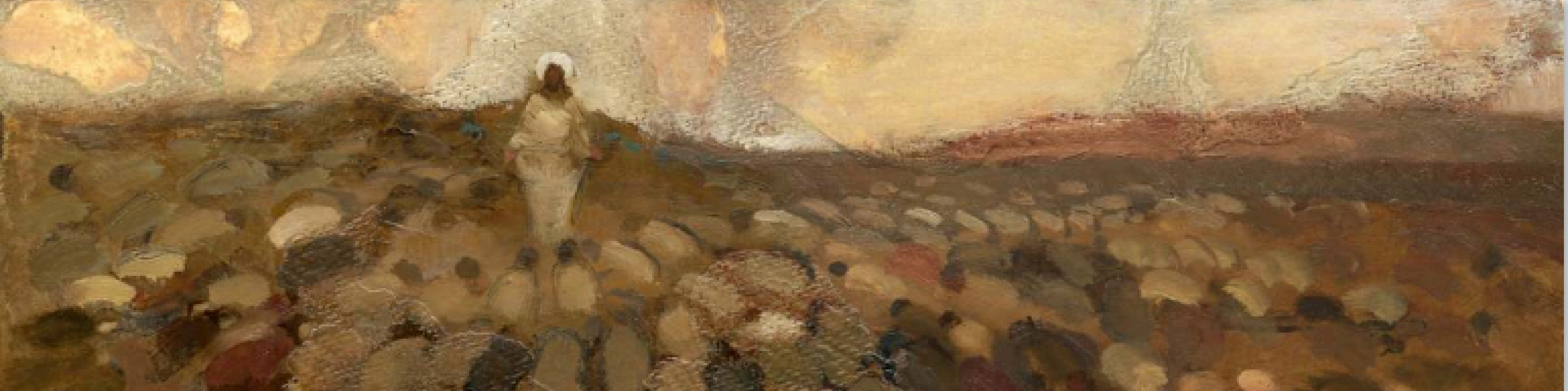


Holy Spirit Continues the Shepherd's Work
