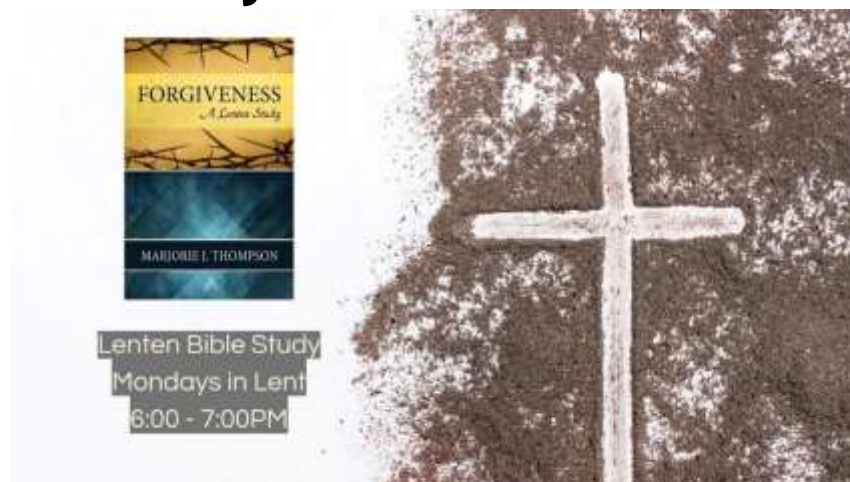
I hope that you will join us for this important message.
