Message from Pastor Jeff



The forty days between now and Easter (not counting Sundays) is called Lent. For those who observe Lent, fasting takes a prominent place. Jesus assumed his followers would fast (Matthew 6:16). Fasting was a consistent practice for all God's people throughout Scripture. It is also one of the most misunderstood practices.

Fasting is not about punishing yourself or showing how devoted you are, but is about making space for God and reminding yourself of where all the true good comes from. Fasting is simply choosing to step away from something you normally rely on for a set time in order to create space for God to work in your life in a fresh way. You can fast from food, social media, meat, soda, or any other thing that you regularly reach for.

One of the gifts of fasting is that it reveals what we turn to for comfort or control. When we remove something familiar that we normally reach for, we become aware of our desires, our restlessness, our impatience, and our anxieties. Fasting gives us the opportunity to bring all these things to God and to recognize that He alone is our ultimate satisfaction and peace.

For followers of Jesus, these times of fasting aren't focused on what we are giving up, but rather on the One who graciously gives us life. Therefore, we don't boast in our fast or go around looking miserable, but live with the joy of those who have discovered the treasure of relationship with God. I encourage you during these forty days to consider joining us in fasting as we prepare ourselves to celebrate the good news of Christ's resurrection.

Grace Men Help Lead Men's Retreat in Turkey *from Rick Ralston*

Recently, Scott Tidwell and I were blessed to be part of a once in a lifetime opportunity to not only travel internationally, but to serve in the name of Christ. We wanted to share some of this experience with our church family for both encouragement of this ongoing ministry, prayers for the people we encountered, and the work they will do moving forward.

In the small town in Turkey, we spent five days serving nine men. Three of them were Americans who have spent many years there on mission,



working diligently to spread the Good News. The other six were native Turkish men, in search of something different, TRUTH.

Organizing an international men's retreat was a first for the Hot Springs based ministry, For King and Kingdom (4KK). 4KK was established to call men into their kingdom destiny, leaving behind the events and experiences of the past that so often rule us, keeping men from becoming the Christian leader they are called to be. 4KK has had over 2000 men experience the retreat. The ministry has twenty-three participating churches, operating in five states. Grace Community is one of those churches. Grace has had twenty-five men who have participated in what the men in Turkey were blessed to experience.

While we were serving these men, we witnessed release of burdens, freedom from strongholds, brotherly connection and bonding, that glorified God and established the Kingdom in the here and now. This is a big deal when we witness this at one of our Grace retreats, but something about it being in Turkey magnified it.

Turkish culture is predominantly Muslim, only .4% of the population identifies as Christian. While persecution is not overt, there is much discrimination related to being Christian. We were advised to keep a low profile. There were many struggles discussed as these brave men left family and friends to pursue the One True God. These men displayed passion for the pursuit of God and a passion for the souls of those they knew did not know TRUTH.

Listening to prayers for other men in the Turkish language moved us. We did not know what was being said, but it didn't matter. So many things divide us, language, food, habits, lifestyle differences, clothing choices, etc... but prayer to our God in any language unites.

We were blessed by an invitation to a Sunday Christian Church Service and Communion. Songs we knew were sung in Turkish, but that did not inhibit our worship or reverence for God, it only enhanced it. What God was doing in that place was on full display. The pastor's message was on Psalm 77. Lord, have you abandoned me? Have you not heard my cries? The pastor made a bold case for the experience and voice of God in the midst of difficulty which is all too real for those living in Turkey, a country that does not believe in Jesus as God. We were moved by their service and the pastor's message was not theoretical, it was practical for many in attendance.

There is so much more that could be shared, as we were steeped in Turkish culture and blessed by the experience. We would love to share more if anyone is curious just hit us up. In the meantime, please pray for Ahmet, Joey, Efe, Zachery, Batuhan, Emry, Aziz, Metin, and Mario. Additionally, Grace men have another opportunity to participate in a 4KK retreat this coming up on April, anyone interested can contact, [Rick](#), Scott, or [JD](#) Cunny.
