We are especially thankful for your Christmas giving which enabled us to supply gifts to all the children that we are reaching in Mongolia and the lepers that we help in Thailand. We thank you from the bottom of our hearts.

December Report: We were able to have Christmas services in all our Churches in the Gobi and in the capital city of Ulaanbaatar. Like all the previous years before, our Church members invite their unsaved friends and family to come and hear the gospel. These meetings are going on pretty much at the same time, so we receive reports of attendance and if any received Christ from the Pastors of each congregation. All reported that the Church houses were full and many people prayed to receive Christ. We praise the Lord for the ones that accepted Christ.

Through your giving, we were able to have Christmas celebrations at our feeding centers, prolife centers, and children's churches throughout the Gobi and Ulaanbaatar. The families of the children were invited and all the children received gifts. We were able to share the gospel and give all the attending families a copy of the book of Mark in the Mongolian language. Our main reason for being here is to deliver the gospel and we were able to do just that. Hundreds were able to hear through our Mongolian pastors, Church leaders, and ministry leaders in their own language. We praise God for making this possible.

We also held a Christmas service and celebration with the lepers in Thailand with gifts for all the lepers and our workers as well. Our joy of the birth of Christ was overshadowed with sorrow by the death of one of our lepers that has lived in our home for many years. He passed to Glory 3 days before Christmas. He was a good Christian man that suffered many years from leprosy and died from cancer. He will be missed by us all. The only family he had was his friends at Home of Grace. Please remember our workers and the lepers at Home of Grace as they grieve his death.

John 16:22 And ye now therefore have sorrow; but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you.









Christmas morning the orphanage children delighted in having a joyful day. Your faithful giving allowed us to give them all a bright Christmas morning with gifts and good
