The Pastor will cultivate ministries where students are known, mentored, and equipped to follow Jesus – and where graduating youth remain engaged and growing within the life of the church.

- Foster a welcoming and relational environment where all youth and young adults are drawn into authentic community.
- Create meaningful opportunities for youth and young adults to discover and use their spiritual gifts through leadership, service, and outreach.
- Complete administrative tasks related to the ministry, including budgets, permission forms, and ministry reports.
