

"An Intentional Lent"

Hello Everyone,

This past Ash Wednesday marked the **beginning of Lent**. This forty-day contemplative period concludes on **Palm Sunday**. The intention of our forebears was to direct people to intentionally consider the **life and sacrifice of Christ**. There is a three-fold foci which was influenced by the teachings of three Saints- Benedict, Leo the Great and St Chrysostom. It is as follows:

1. Final preparations for those seeking **baptism at the Easter Vigil**.
2. A period leading to **restoration** for those alienated from the church.
3. A time of preparation for all the faithful leading up to the annual celebration of the paschal mystery of the **death and resurrection of Christ**.

For Benedict, Lenten disciplines should be followed **throughout the year**. So, for him Lent, should include disciplines "**taken on**" rather than things abstained from.

The Gospel reading for Ash Wednesday from **Matthew 6** provides the essential dimensions of our **Lenten disciplines: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving**. Thomas Cranmer wrote a new collect for the **1549 Prayer Book**, shifting the emphasis from **fasting to penitence**. Cranmer's preamble drew from the prayer for the blessing of the ashes and clearly the introit (above). His petition is grounded in Psalm 51- a penitential psalm which is featured several times in the Lenten season.

In this important season, I urge you to take the opportunity to be intentional in your **relationship with Christ**. You may wish to choose to go without something that you prefer. On the other hand, you may want to adopt a new discipline -**such as prayer or the daily reading of Scripture**. Whatever you so choose, I encourage you to take stock of your relationship as you develop **healthier habits and disciplines**.

Finally, I offer you the original prayer that **Thomas Cranmer** included in the early Anglican Book of Common Prayer.
