

Belcher Family to Guam Prayer Letter

Here we are coming to the end of 2025, it sure has been an amazing year here at Bible Baptist Church and we are excited to share with you what God has done here in September and October! Starting in September, we had two Bible clubs, one in the village of Yona and the other in the village of Talafofo. The Lord blessed both tremendously, but at the Bible Club in Talafofo, we had a family of 4 come and join us, I got to talk to the dad, Matthew and invite him to church. The next day during the morning service, he and his wife, Frankie Ann, and their two kids came into to church. After the service, I gave the altar call and Frankie Ann came forward, after talking to her after the service, Frankie Ann bowed her head in prayer and got saved!

A few weeks later we had our first youth rally held at Bible Baptist Church, what a wonderful night! Four churches were represented, and we had a phenomenal time! Guam may be limited on prenatal care, but God has provided and continues to provide the care Rebecca and Baby Iden need. Please continue to pray that they stay safe through the rest of the pregnancy and the delivery.
