Our February Missionaries of the Month are **J and his wife B** who serve with MTW. They are engaged in very challenging work in a hostile region. Marseille, France— **Hugh Wessel** asks that we pray for his dear ministry partner, Pastor Samuel Kabo who has connections to the Reformed church of the Central African Republic (CAR). In response to a concern over doctrinal problems witnessed by reformed pastors in the CAR, Pastor Kabo is starting an initiative to support and strengthen the ministry of those churches. The Reformed Evangelical Churches of France (UNEPREF) has donated 3,000 copies of a systematic theology for lay people entitled *The Reasons for Our Hope*. Pastor Kabo plans to personally deliver the first of these books as well as provide pastoral teaching times aimed at reinforcing biblical foundations, promoting doctrinal clarity and promoting servant leadership for the pastors of the CAR. He asks for prayers for his safety, for purity and unity within the church and for wisdom, humility and faithfulness as he takes on this endeavor.
