Many people still watch the television show, "The Office" even though its last episode came out in 2013. Part of the appeal of the show is the relationships that the characters have. One of those relationships between Jim and Pam turns into marriage. Many times during their relationship they will pretend to take a picture of the moment that they are having so they can always remember it. This is of course before cell phones became wildly popular and everyone was taking pictures of everything. I bring the "pictures" up from the Office because there is something about remembering moments and people that is very very important. In fact, I would say that as Christians we should be "snapping pictures" of God's grace to us. I don't mean actually taking pictures but we should be committing to memory the things that God has done for us, His faithfulness to us, and how He lavishes His grace on us.

Just as we can look at an old picture or a memory on social media and have all sorts of feelings stirred within us, when we remember what God has done and how God has blessed us that should stir us as well. It should stir us to worship and thanksgiving. It should stir us in service. It should draw us closer to Jesus, and it should stir us to tell someone about Him. There is value in remembering the goodness and the greatness of God. The Bible tells us that "we should consider how we can stir one another up toward love and good deeds." In other words, we should be thinking about how we can motivate each other in our walks with Jesus. One way that we can certainly do that is by sharing with each other the goodness of God.

In the Old Testament they are instructed on numerous occasions to set up "memorials" so they can remember God's goodness to them and the great things He has done. These memorials of course encourage them to worship, but they also give them strength and hope for the future. Life would sometimes be very difficult for God's people; they could then see those memorials and remember what God had done in the past and then they could know God brought us through hard times then and He can bring us through hard times now. Setting up memorials also allowed them to teach the next generation what God had done. It became a witness. All of these things are still true today, when we look back and remember it strengthens our faith, it gives us reason to worship, and it is a witness to the world. So lets "snap those picture", lets commit to remember God's goodness and grace and lets then celebrate Him and live every
