The results showed some small "manchas" or spots on the brain. This prompted them to have an MRI which could not be done there, since that particular hospital was not equipped with MRI technology. So, Pablo had to be transported by ambulance to another facility where they could perform the MRI. Bro. Danny said they are awaiting the results. At least the situation seems to be less tense at this point. But they are concerned about the "manchas." Please keep praying. I'll follow up later.
