Apostle's Creed- I believe in Jesus Christ

1. **When you hear the phrase “Jesus Christ, God’s only Son, our Lord,” which part feels most natural to embrace—and which part do you find most challenging? Why do you think that is?**
2. **The sermon says Christianity is centered on a *person*, not a system or set of rules. How does that reframe the way you think about faith, obedience, or spiritual growth?**
3. **The creed is described as something that doesn’t just inform us but *form* us. Can you think of a belief you’ve confessed before it fully felt true—and how that confession shaped you over time?**
4. **We often love Jesus as Savior but struggle with Jesus as Lord. Where do you see that tension playing out in your own life right now?**
5. **The sermon names things like money, success, comfort, and even family as potential “false lords.” Which of these—or others—are most tempting for you to give ultimate authority to? How can you tell?**
6. **Philippians 2 describes Jesus as both humble and exalted, obedient and authoritative. How does that vision of Jesus reshape what authority and leadership should look like in our own lives?**
7. **This week’s practice asks the question: “What part of my life have I not handed over to you, Lord Jesus?” As much as you’re comfortable sharing, what surfaced for you—and what might surrender look like in concrete terms this week?**
