A word from Pastor Justin

Dear Mt. Pisgah Family,

This winter has certainly made itself known. We have walked through snow, navigated ice, bundled up against the cold, and found ourselves longing for the warmth of spring. There is something about these gray and frozen days that teaches us patience. We know the green buds are coming. We know the warmth will return. But for now, we wait... and Lent feels much the same.

In Matthew 4, we hear of Jesus being led by the Spirit into the wilderness. Forty days of hunger, temptation, silence, and preparation. But it's important to note, the wilderness was not the end of Jesus' story, it was the beginning of something deeper. It was the place where faith was strengthened and clarity was formed before his public ministry unfolded. **Lent invites us into that same wilderness walk.**

This is not a season of despair. It is a season of formation. It is a season where we slow down, reflect, repent, and allow God to shape us. Just as the earth lies dormant beneath the frozen ground, roots are still growing beneath the surface. In the quiet, unseen places, transformation is happening. Spiritually, we are preparing the soil of our hearts. **The wilderness does not last forever. Spring does not delay indefinitely. Resurrection is coming.**

And when Easter morning arrives, it is not simply a celebration of something that happened long ago, **it is the proclamation that Christ renews us now.** That death does not win. That sin does not define us. That hope rises again.

As we continue this Lenten journey together, I invite you to lean into the practices that help us grow. Join us for our **Midweek Lenten Services at 6:15 pm**, where we are focusing on prayer, meditation, and creating space to simply be with God. Before worship, **we gather for a meal together at 5:15 pm**, a beautiful reminder that faith is formed not only in worship but also around tables and conversation. These evenings are intentionally reflective and grounding, offering a pause in the middle of busy weeks.

Then, as we approach Holy Week, we will gather for **Maundy Thursday on April 2nd at 6:00 pm and Good Friday on April 3rd at 6:00 pm.** These sacred services walk us through love, sacrifice, and the depth of Christ's commitment to us. Finally, we will celebrate the joy of resurrection together on Easter morning during our **Sunrise Contemporary Service at 6:30 am and our Traditional Indoor Service at 9:00 am.**

From wilderness to resurrection. From cold to warmth. From waiting to rejoicing. God is at work in this season, in the quiet growth beneath the surface, in the refining of our faith, and in the hope that is steadily rising. May this Lent be a time of deep roots and renewed hearts.





We will continue our Sunday School Series: The Chosen – Season 5



Wednesday Bible Study class will continue their Bible Study, "*Revelation*".


