

- *We've just heard the Presiding Minister remind us [INSERT LAW/GOSPEL STATEMENT].*
- *For the rest of the service, we invite you, whenever you feel called, to respond to God's word through*
 - *Praying one-on-one with our prayer minister*
 - *Lighting a candle*
 - *Remembering your baptism*
 - *Dropping off a prayer request in the box at the back of the church*
 - *Giving to support our shared ministry either in that same box or via the QR code*

- *Or by joining your voice to ours as we lift up prayers through song*
- *Once a month, instead of Josh, the Presiding Minister invites the congregation to respond to the message by coming forward as they feel moved to receive communion.*

Communion is offered at one station where the bread and only individual cups are placed on stands. One communion server is at the station along with the Presiding Minister.

Response: Lead Me to the Light

As the music continues, and as people move to respond however they feel called, the Assisting Minister says:
