Today we will be celebrating Holy Communion.

Visitors are welcome to share with us the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, given and shed for us, for the forgiveness of sins.

The Mission Board has designated the Marion Medical Mission as our March Mission of the month. Total giving to the Wells Project for 2025 was \$6,573.00, for almost 14 wells! Thirteen wells have already been built in villages in 4 different countries: *Malawi, Zambia, Tanzania and Mozambique*, with a total of 1605 people in those villages now have healthy, clean drinking water. They no longer have to drink water from contaminated streams and waterholes. The lifespan of these 1605 people have been significantly increased because they now have clean water to drink. Thank you for giving the gift of life with the gift of clean water.

In January 2026, we raised \$612.86 for another 1.29 wells. Let's see how many more wells we can sponsor this year! ***If you would like to donate, please make checks payable to Trinity Lutheran Church and note on check memo or in offering envelope "Mission Fund."***

As we've done every year since I've been here, we will once again hold **Lenten Worship Services** at Twilight Vista and Avera Care Center, alternating between the two on Monday afternoons at 2:00 PM.
