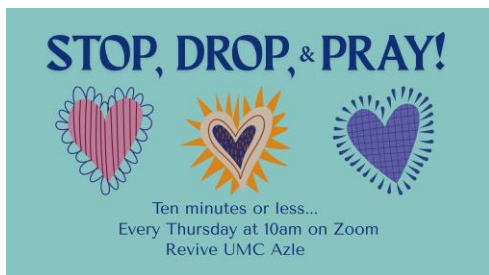
Ongoing Activities
