### **Building Update**

Two committees are currently working on early plans for a possible building program.

It is not developing a full design, but envisioning how a sanctuary could fit on our property and how other parts of the property would change.

> **Capital Campaign Committee** - Chair: Stephen Frey. This committee is working on preliminary plans for raising funds for a possible project. They are seeking wisdom and developing proposals.

## Who Should Participate in the Lord's Supper?

At Chapel, the Bible guides our participation in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper. Please take the elements only if you can affirm these questions:

### **1 - Am I united in membership with an evangelical church?**

An evangelical church is one that teaches we are saved by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. We invite members in good standing of these churches to receive the sacrament with us.

### **2 - Am I receiving the sacrament in a spirit of unity?**

Jesus spoke of the importance of resolving conflicts before worship, and Paul warned against disunity in the early church. Before you participate in the sacrament, please do all you can to seek and extend forgiveness and pursue reconciliation with other believers.

If you have never prayed to receive Jesus as Savior and Lord, we hope you will do this today. If you do, please let us know so we can celebrate with you and guide you in your new life.
