 - What are some ways that you would suggest building a strong life of prayer and other spiritual disciplines like fasting?
 - How can we distinguish between our voice when trying to listen for/ to God and Gods voice?
 - How do we navigate generosity while also balancing good stewardship of our resources in other ways?
 - What would your tips be on how can we learn and decipher bible but not get it confused or misinterpreted it?
