### Apostle's Creed- Conceived and Born

*“Conceived by the Holy Spirit, Born of the Virgin Mary”:*

1. The sermon described the Apostles' Creed as both *informative* and *transformative*. In what ways has your faith become more about information than transformation? What would it look like for the truth of the incarnation to shape your daily life?
2. Hebrews 2 teaches that Jesus became fully human in order to rescue us. How does knowing that Jesus has experienced real human weakness, pain, and temptation change the way you approach him in prayer?
3. The incarnation is described as a paradox — fully God and fully human. Where do you personally struggle with doubt or confusion about Jesus' identity? How might embracing mystery deepen, rather than weaken, your faith?
4. The sermon emphasized that sin separates us from a holy God and that we cannot fix the problem ourselves. Where do you most feel the limits of your own ability to “fix” yourself or your world?
5. If Jesus were only a moral teacher, his death would simply be tragic. How does understanding his death as God's rescue mission reshape how you view the cross?
6. Hebrews 2:17 says Jesus became fully human to make atonement for us. What does it mean practically for you to live as someone who has been forgiven and reconciled to God?
7. The sermon concluded by saying you know you're beginning to understand the incarnation when it leads you to worship. What currently stirs genuine worship in your heart? What might be hindering it?
