



# Aligned at the Table

**Theme:** Personal Holiness • Servant Leadership • Spiritual Alignment

## The one thing to know:

This is not a season of noise; it is a season of alignment.

God is not asking the Church to do more - He is calling us to be right.

**Right in heart. Right in posture. Right in obedience.**

- **Before God releases authority, He restores holiness.**
- **Before He promotes leaders, He forms servants.**
- **And before He moves through a people, He aligns them at His table.**

### 1. **Personal Holiness: The Alignment of the Heart -**

1 Peter 1:16 - "Be holy, for I am holy." 1 Peter 1:16

- Holiness is not perfection - it is direction.
- It is the decision to let God search us, confront us, and cleanse us.
- **Many want God's power without God's process.**
- But God anoints clean vessels, not gifted ones alone.

This is the hour where God is separating appearance from substance.

What you do in secret is aligning—or misaligning—your destiny.

**Prophetic declaration: "Lord, realign my heart before You realign my assignment."**

### 2. **Servant Leadership: The Alignment of Posture**

John 13:14 - "If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet."

- True leadership in the Kingdom is not about position but submission.
- **Jesus did not lead from a throne - He led from a towel.**
- The world says, "Be served to be great, but Jesus says, "Serve to be trusted."

**Servant leadership keeps us:**

- Humble when praised
- Teachable when corrected
- Faithful when unseen

**God is raising leaders who do not compete, compare, or control—but carry hearts like Christ.**

Prophetic insight:

**God is removing titles that were worn without tears and restoring authority to those who still kneel.**

**2. Spiritual Alignment: The Alignment of the Body**

1 Corinthians 11:29 - "For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body."

**Spiritual alignment means living in agreement with:**

- **God's Word**
- **God's Spirit**
- **God's timing**

Misalignment causes frustration, dryness, and confusion - even in church. But alignment restores peace, clarity, and power.

Paul warns the church not only about sin, but also about discerning the body.

For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body." (1 Corinthians 11:29)

**This is not condemnation - it is correction with mercy.**

God is saying:

**"Before you take My bread, let Me heal My body."**

Transition to the Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper is not a ritual - it is a realignment altar.

**At the table:**

- **Holiness is restored**
- **Pride is crucified**

- **Servants are formed**
- **Unity is sealed**

We do not come because we are worthy - we come because He is faithful.

- The bread says: Your body matters.
- The cup says: Your sins are forgiven.
- The table says: Come back into alignment.

### **Communion Moment (Slow & Reflective)**

Invite the church to pause.

“But let a man examine himself...” (1 Corinthians 11:28)

Lead them in a quiet prayer:

- Repentance for misalignment
- Surrender of pride
- Renewal of holiness
- Commitment to servant leadership

### **Then declare:**

“As we receive the bread, we receive alignment.

As we receive the cup, we receive cleansing.

As we proclaim His death, we realign our lives to His cross.”

### **Closing Prophetic Charge**

- This table is resetting destinies.
- What was crooked is being straightened.
- What was delayed is being repositioned.
- What was polluted is being purified.

### **Leave this place aligned**

- in heart,
- in service,
- and in spirit.
