BROADWAY UNITED METHODIST CHURCH SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded in recognition of outstanding youth who are regular attenders/members of Broadway United Methodist Church. All High School graduates and GED recipients are eligible to apply to the scholarship committee before **Saturday, April 25, 2026**.

STANDARDS OF ELIGIBILITY - ALL APPLICANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS MUST BE:

- A member/participant of Broadway United Methodist Church
- Actively involved in church and community activities
(i.e. regular attendance in worship, Wed. evenings, Bible school, Sunday School, UM youth groups, camps, choir, service projects), and demonstrate leadership.
- Scholastically competent by maintaining a **2.75 GPA** (4.0 scale)
- Attending accredited schools, enrolled with a **minimum of 12 hours EACH semester for the upcoming school year**
- Special consideration is given to applicants entering church-related occupations.

Once you have received an initial Broadway UMC scholarship you may apply for additional scholarship funding for up to 3 consecutive years (making the total possible scholarships rewarded to per student 4). You must still qualify with the criteria listed above - both GPA & hours/semester. Another example would be if you graduated from high school with enough credits to start as a sophomore in college, you could still apply 3 more consecutive years which may now include hours in a graduate program. This would complete your 4-year cycle. Please note, we are not accepting graduate school scholarship applications unless it is completing your 4-year cycle.

Scholarships will be announced at both church services on May 17th - Senior/Scholarship Sunday . Scholarship checks will be mailed to the recipients in late July.
