The lesson this week is:  
**“Woman at the Well”**

Scripture Reading: John 4: 5-42



*“Today is the **third Sunday in Lent**. The colour for Lent is **purple**. Purple is a colour that **kings and queens** wear. During Lent, we remember that **Christ is a king**.”*

*The woman at the well saw **Jesus** and knew he was the **Messiah**. A **messiah** is someone who comes to **lead** and to **save people**. Jesus came to **teach** us about God and to **show** us how to live. The woman realized that **Jesus** was a different kind of king and wanted to tell everyone about him. We can **trust and follow Jesus**.”*


