SERMON "GOD'S COVENANT LOVE: RESTING IN THE FAITHFUL GOD"

Ephraim is like a dove, silly and without sense, calling to Egypt, going to Assyria. (Hosea 7:11)

For they sow the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind. The standing grain has no heads; it shall yield no flour; if it were to yield, strangers would devour it. ⁸Israel is swallowed up; already they are among the nations as a useless vessel. ⁹For they have gone up to Assyria, a wild donkey wandering alone; Ephraim has hired lovers. ¹⁰Though they hire allies among the nations, I will soon gather them up. And the king and princes shall soon writhe because of the tribute. (Hosea 8:7-10)

Ephraim feeds on the wind and pursues the east wind all day long; they multiply falsehood and violence; they make a covenant with Assyria, and oil is carried to Egypt. (Hosea 12:1)
