## LIVING THE CHANGE

**March Series: Living The Change**

**Week Focus: Living the Transformed Life**

**Scripture- Romans 12:2**

*“Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.”*

### Devotional Reflection

This week was never only about learning new ideas — it was about formation. God has been quietly at work shaping your thinking, strengthening your responses, and reinforcing new rhythms in your daily life.

Romans 12:2 reminds us that transformation happens through the renewing of the mind. This renewal is not always dramatic or immediate. Most often, it unfolds gradually as God reshapes the way we see situations, interpret challenges, and respond to people.

Because of this, transformation can sometimes feel subtle while it is happening. We may not notice it right away because the changes are often small and quiet. But over time, the evidence begins to appear in everyday moments.

You may notice calmer reactions where frustration once surfaced quickly. You may recognize wiser decisions forming where confusion once dominated. Emotions that once felt overwhelming may begin to feel steadier and more grounded. Trust in God’s guidance may grow stronger where worry once took control.

These are not random improvements — they are signs that God’s work is taking root within you.

Spiritual transformation rarely happens through one powerful moment alone. It develops through repeated alignment with God’s truth. Every time you pause before reacting, choose grace over impulse, return to Scripture for clarity, or trust God in uncertain situations, you are reinforcing the new life He is forming in you.

As you reflect today, resist the temptation to measure your progress harshly. Growth that lasts is often gradual. Instead of focusing on what still needs to change, take time to notice what has already shifted.

God is patient with the work He does in our lives. The same God who began this transformation in you is faithfully continuing it. He is shaping your character, strengthening your foundation, and forming a life that reflects Him more clearly over time.

So today is a moment to pause and recognize the quiet evidence of God's work.

Stay surrendered.

Stay responsive.

Stay consistent.

Even when progress feels slow, remember this truth:

You are living the change — often more than you realize.
