## TRUSTING GOD'S STEPS

**Week Focus: Ordered Steps, Steady Growth**

**Scripture- Psalm 37:23**

*"The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord."*

### Devotional Reflection

Scripture reminds us that the steps of a righteous person are ordered by the Lord. This does not mean life will always feel predictable or easy. Instead, it means God is actively involved in guiding the direction of our lives. Even when circumstances shift or the future feels uncertain, God remains attentive to every step we take.

Many people desire clarity about the entire future. We want to see the whole path before we begin walking. Yet God often reveals His guidance one step at a time. By doing this, He teaches us to trust Him daily rather than depending only on our own understanding or plans.

Trust grows when we learn to follow God in the small moments. Sometimes His guidance comes through Scripture, wise counsel, or a quiet sense of conviction in our hearts. Each step of obedience becomes an opportunity to recognize that God is present and actively shaping our journey.

When we surrender our steps to God, we begin to experience a deeper kind of stability. Instead of feeling pressured to control every outcome, we develop confidence that God is guiding our direction. Over time, this steady trust builds patience, wisdom, and spiritual maturity.

Today is an invitation to trust the steps God is guiding, even if the entire path is not yet visible. The same God who has been faithful in the past is continuing to lead you forward today.
