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MATTHEW 5:1-12

[1] Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him.

[2] And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying:

[3] “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

[4] “Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

[5] “Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

[6] “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

[7] “Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.

[8] “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

[9] “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

[10] “Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness’ sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

[11] “Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. [12] Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you. (ESV)

Reflection Questions:

1. What am I actually hungry for? Taking an honest look at where I spend my time, money, and mental energy this past week — what does that reveal about what I am truly hungering and thirsting for? Is God at the centre of it?
2. Where is God trying to get my attention? Is there a restlessness, a dissatisfaction, or a difficulty in my life right now that might be God’s megaphone — an invitation to turn my hunger toward Him rather than away from Him?
3. When did I last truly taste that God is good? Can I think of a moment when I experienced God’s grace in a real, personal way? What happened to my hunger for Him after that? And if I can’t think of one — what would it look like to bring that honestly to God today?
