Chronological Bible Teaching




CMC Library Corner with Susan James

You will need a can of pie filling and a package of refrigerated crescent rolls. Preheat oven to 375 degrees.

Open crescent rolls and lay triangle sections inside greased muffin tin. Spoon pie filling inside and fold dough over with the top overlapping. Bake for 13-15 minutes or till golden brown.

Sprinkle powdered sugar over the top or serve with vanilla ice cream.
