Group Discussion Questions

1. Where in your life do you currently need to practice more “childlike faith”? What would it look like this week to depend on Jesus more intentionally in that area?
2. Is there something specific you sense God asking you to surrender right now? What makes letting go of that thing difficult?
3. The rich young ruler walked away because he was unwilling to release what mattered most to him. What helps you recognize when something good has become an idol in your life?
4. Jesus challenged the young man out of love. How can remembering Christ’s love change the way we respond when God convicts us or asks us to change?
5. Think about the difference between self-reliance and dependence on God. In what situations do you tend to rely on yourself instead of seeking the Lord first?
6. The sermon emphasized that Jesus gave up everything to come for us. How does reflecting on the cross help reshape what we value most in life?
7. What is one practical step you can take this week to loosen your grip on something that may be competing with your devotion to Christ?
8. Who in your life could help you stay accountable as you work through the area God is challenging you about?
