Discussion Questions

1. What first brought you to Westside, and what has kept you here? Can you share a moment when this church community had a meaningful impact on your faith or life?
2. The people of Westside in the 1960s invested to build the space we use today. How have you personally benefited from what they built?
3. How do you think improving our building's accessibility and functionality could impact people who come here in the future?
4. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-8. What do you know about the context of this passage? What stands out to you in this passage about generosity? Why do you think Paul emphasizes giving cheerfully rather than reluctantly or under compulsion? What do you think it means practically to "sow generously" in a situation like this? What principles do you think this passage give us when it comes to the idea of generosity and investing in kingdom initiatives (and a project like our Making Space For Everyone Campaign?)
5. Have you begun thinking or praying about the pledge card? What thoughts or questions have come to mind? What might it look like for you personally to participate in this campaign (through prayer, generosity, or supporting the vision)?
