Cup of Wrath

Genesis 6:3: And the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.”



God gave
them over:
Romans
1:24-28

24 Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another. 25 They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen.

26 Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lusts. Even their women exchanged natural sexual relations for unnatural ones. 27 In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed shameful acts with other men, and received in themselves the due penalty for their error.

28 Furthermore, just as they did not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, so God gave them over to a depraved mind, so that they do what ought not to be done.

Iran's Regime's theology

Iran's ruling establishment, rooted in Twelver Shi'ite theology, believes the end of the world (eschaton) is triggered by the return of the Hidden Imam (the Mahdi). This event is accelerated by a violent, apocalyptic scenario, including the "liberation" of Jerusalem, destruction of Israel, and confrontation with Western powers.

Support for Proxy Militias and Terror Organizations

Arming and Training Proxies: Iran provides weapons, funding, and training to various groups, including Lebanese Hezbollah, Hamas, Palestinian Islamic Jihad, and the Houthis in Yemen.

Hezbollah (Lebanon): Iran is the primary sponsor of Hezbollah, providing hundreds of millions of dollars annually.

Hamas and Islamic Jihad (Gaza/West Bank): Iran supplies financial, political, and military support to these groups, including funding for attacks against Israel.

Houthi Rebels (Yemen): Iran has provided drones, missiles, and training to the Houthis, who have targeted commercial shipping in the Red Sea and attacked Saudi Arabia and the UAE.

Iraqi Militias: The IRGC-Quds Force (IRGC-QF) supports Iraqi Shia militias that have attacked U.S. and coalition forces in Iraq.

Attacks on U.S. and Allied Personnel

Targeting U.S. Forces (Iraq/Syria): Iran-backed militias have conducted hundreds of attacks against U.S. forces in the region, including drone and rocket attacks, particularly surging after October 7, 2023.

2024 Tower 22 Attack: Iran-backed Kataib Hezbollah killed three U.S. service members in a drone attack on a base in Jordan.

1983/1984 Beirut Bombings: Hezbollah, with Iranian support, bombed the U.S. Embassy and Marine barracks in Beirut, killing over 300 people.

1996 Khobar Towers Bombing: Iran was held responsible for the bombing that killed 19 U.S. servicemen in Saudi Arabia.

Support for Al-Qaeda: Iran has been accused of allowing a "core facilitation pipeline" for al-Qaeda to move funds and fighters.

International Assassinations and Terror Plots

European

Operations: Iran has orchestrated plots to assassinate dissidents in European countries, including Denmark, the Netherlands, and Belgium.

Plot Against Donald

Trump: In November 2024, an Iranian national was charged in a plot to assassinate Donald Trump.

Plot Against John

Bolton: An IRGC member was charged in 2022 with plotting to murder former U.S. National Security Advisor John Bolton.

Kidnapping Attempt in New York: In 2021, Iranian intelligence was implicated in a plot to kidnap an Iranian-American journalist from her home in Brooklyn.

1994 AMIA Bombing

(Argentina): Iran was implicated in the bombing of a Jewish community center in Buenos Aires that killed 85 people.

2012 Bulgaria Bus

Bombing: Hezbollah, with Iranian backing, bombed a bus of Israeli tourists in Burgas.

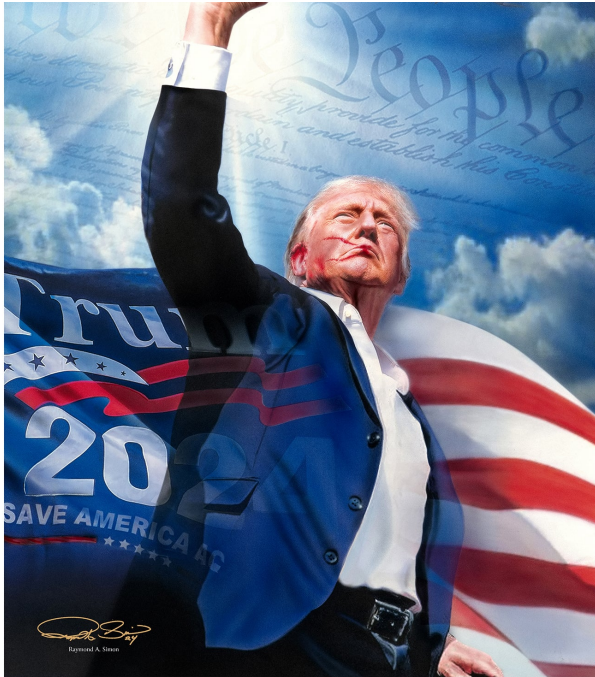

End of World War 2: When MacArthur took Charge of Japan

Key details regarding MacArthur's request and efforts:

Missionary Request: MacArthur asked for "1,000 missionaries" (sometimes cited as "thousands" in various reports) to assist in rebuilding the nation.

Bible Distribution: He encouraged the shipment of 10 million Bibles to Japan.

Support for Education: He supported the establishment of Christian educational institutions, such as the International Christian University.

Motivation: MacArthur believed "true democracy can exist only on a spiritual foundation" and felt that Christianity provided that basis.
